In an effort to address the capacity needs of the Southern African Development Community (SADC) water sector, the Southern African Science Service Centre for Climate Change and Adaptive Land Management (SASSCAL) established the SASSCAL Graduate Studies Programme in Integrated Water Resources Management (SGSP – IWRM) at the Namibia University of Science and Technology. The programme is implemented by NUST in partnership with the International Centre of Water Resources and Global Change based at the Institute of Hydrology in Koblenz Germany. The SGSP-IWRM is fully funded by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). The objective of the SGSP – IWRM is to develop and deploy an innovative and excellent regional collaborative education and research programme at the PhD level complemented by selected tailor-made short courses.

Post-Doctoral Researcher: SGSP-IWRM (2 Years Contract) Requirements

A relevant Doctorate (NQF Level 10) with at least two years of lecturing or research experience at tertiary education level and/or industry experience or an equivalent combination of relevant professional experience post obtaining the doctoral qualification. Excellent English communication (oral and written), computer and interpersonal skills. Sound knowledge in teaching methods; designing of courses/modules/curricula development; assessment procedures; quality assurance methods; administrative procedures; knowledge of theory and application in relevant areas and grant writing. Competence to exercise independent discretion and judgment in carrying out research activities within the predetermined research scope and methodology of the GSP.

Key Performance Areas

Organise and implement complex research plans, develop methods of research and collect, analyse and evaluate data, prepare descriptive, analytical and evaluative reports. Lecture, develop curricula (including short courses) and conduct research and community engagement activities and administration.
